



SOUTH AFRICA MARCH 2010 SHARK DIVING AND SAFARI TRIP

Saturday	Depart Nice to Paris, connecting to overnight flight to South Africa
Sunday	Arrives Johannesburg, connecting flight to Durban where you will be met and transferred to your KwaZulu Natal south coast accommodation for 6 nights
Monday – Thursday	2 dives per day at Aliwal Shoal and Protea Banks, looking for different shark species: in March (summer) you can expect to see lots of game fish which brings in the Tiger sharks, Zambezis (Bull sharks), Hammerheads, Blacktip/Spinner sharks (this is not the same as Blacktip reef sharks), Giant guitar sharks. Water temperature should be around 26 – 28 degrees centigrade
Friday	Speciality Tiger shark dive
Saturday	Transfer to Hluhluwe Game Reserve for 2 nights, enjoying a night game drive
Sunday	Full day game drives
Monday	Morning game drive, afternoon transfer to Durban airport for your flight to Johannesburg, connecting to your flight back to France
Tuesday Afternoon	Arrive Paris, connecting to your flight back to Nice arriving

Total Cost £2185 (based on two people sharing accommodation)

These prices are based on us having a minimum of 8 divers giving us exclusive use of a dive boat. The quote is based on March 2009 flights as 2010 rates are not yet available. More accurate costing should be available around middle of 2009 for 2010 rates but a large increase is not anticipated. The quote is subject to availability – no flights or accommodation have been booked

Shark Guarantee - Sharks or your diving is FREE

The people we are using for the holiday are aware that many destinations and operators offer sightings of sharks and when you get there - nothing! Due to the experience and knowledge of their dive team they can guarantee shark sightings on every tour.

The Guarantee: They guarantee that anyone who joins us on a package that includes the Aliwal Shoal and Tiger Shark Diving will have an up-close encounter with sharks, if not you will be refunded the cost of the diving. This is a package offer and doesn't guarantee sharks on every dive although they aim to see sharks on every dive.

The Definition: The 'Shark Guarantee' means the following, a sighting of a shark at a distance of not more than 15m. When sharks are sighted, there are almost always more than one and they often come closer.

The Sharks: The species of sharks that you are most likely to see include Tiger Sharks, Bull [Zambezi] Sharks, Ragged Tooth Sharks, Hammerhead Sharks, Blacktip Sharks, Dusky Sharks, Bronze Whalers [Copper Sharks], Giant Guitar Sharks and Whale Sharks. The 'Shark Guarantee' is not restricted to these species as we are often lucky enough to see others.

The Weather: Should for whatever reason the weather disrupt our diving the 'Shark Guarantee' will still apply provided we have completed at least half the dives and the Tiger Shark Diving, anything less and the 'Shark Guarantee' will be considered void.

The Diving: The diving in South Africa is for Advanced divers and are group activities and if for whatever reason, a diver misses a dive or ends a dive early and the rest of the divers have a shark sighting, they will not be entitled to the refund. Any diver considered to be careless, reckless or disregard safety, thereby jeopardizing our safety, their own safety or the safety of the group, shall not be allowed to dive for the remainder of the tour. In such circumstances there would be no refund.

The Conditions: The operator we are using reserve the right to change dive sites from the days originally stated on the itinerary, as they have constant feedback about the diving and weather conditions and their main aim is to ensure that visitors to South Africa experience the very best they have to offer. You will sign a copy of the 'Shark Guarantee' at the beginning of the tour to ensure that the information is understood.
